The Feast of the Holy Family: on the Sunday immediately after Christmas Day we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family. Jesus, Mary and Joseph constituted a family. Clearly this was a family especially blessed by God. But it was also a family that experienced hardship and suffering by way of example one could think of the precarious circumstances in which Jesus was born or the flight into Egypt or the event recorded in to-day's gospel. The Holy Family is not a model for families today in the sense of being imitated but it is very definitely an inspiration for all families who aspire to living out God's will as fully as possible.

1st of January: Feast of Mary, The Holy Mother of God: on the octave of Christmas our remembrance of Mary's divine motherhood injects a further note of joy. It is a day of prayer for world peace and Mary is the mother of the Prince of Peace. The new year fills our hearts with hope and Mary is certainly a symbol of hope for all God's people. Mary, Mother of God, pray for us.

1st of January: World Day of Peace. The theme chosen by Pope Francis for this year's day of peace is <u>Overcome</u> <u>Indifference and Win Peace</u>.

To build and consolidate peace in the world is a constant challenge. Too often we settle for peace in the sense of the 'absence of violence' but this is a very impoverished understanding of peace. True peace is a much richer experience than that. Peace has to do with all that nurtures and strengthens our humanity. By way of example it means that all people have a sufficient amount of good nourishment, that everyone has an adequate place to live, that people have work opportunities, that people have a good health service, that children and young people have the opportunity to study, that those in public office act justly at all times. Pope Francis is telling us that indifference on our part in relation to these and other areas of life is detrimental to peace. The Irish word Meitheal comes to mind it means a group of people working together for a common purpose. Let us work and pray together for a more peaceful world.
