Pope Francis in his exhortation about marriage and the family says: The pastoral care of newly married couples must also involve encouraging them to be generous in bestowing life. In accord with the personal and fully human character of conjugal love, family planning fittingly takes place as the result of a consensual dialogue between the spouses, respect for times and consideration of the dignity of the partner. (paragraph 222)

The Memorial of the Ukranian Redemporist Martyrs is celebrated on the 28th of June. They are Bishop Nicholas Charnetsky (1884-1959); Bishop Vasyl Velychkovsky (1903-1973); Fr. Zenon Kovalyk (1903-1941) and Fr. Ivan Ziatyk (1899-1952). They died violent deaths at the hands of the communist regime and were beatified in 2001 by Pope John Paul II.

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul is celebrated on the 29th of June: St. Peter was a fisherman who became leader of the apostles and St. Paul was a persecutor of Christians who became the 'Apostle of the Gentiles'.

The Memorial of Blessed Gennaro Sarnelli (Redemptorist) is celebrated on the 30th of June. He worked together with Alphonsus Liguori on the 'Street Missions', gathering people in groups on the streets, to explore faith together. Later Gennaro joined the Congregation founded by Alphonsus.
