**The Feast of St. Oliver Plunkett** is celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July. He was born in 1625 to a wealthy family in Loughcrew, Co. Meath. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1654 and became archbishop of Armagh in 1669. Ten years later he was arrested and tried for conspiring against the state. He was martyred on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 1681 at Tyburn. During his time as archbishop he worked to reform the clergy and to make education accessible for as many people as possible. He was canonised in 1975 by Pope Paul VI.
