The Feast of St James the Apostle is celebrated on the 25th of July. James was one of the Twelve Apostles and traditionally considered the first apostle to be martyred. He and his brother John, also an apostle, sought privilege but were reminded by Jesus that the purpose of authority is to serve. He is probably best remembered because of the Camino to Santiago de Compostela where his remains were buried.

The Feast of St. Joachim and St. Anne is celebrated on the 26th of July. The parents of Mary of Nazareth represent generations of people who faithfully perform their duties, practise their faith but remain in the background. This day is in a sense 'grandparents' day and is a reminder to us how important grandparents are in the wider family circle.
