**The joy of love: a joy for all the earth.**

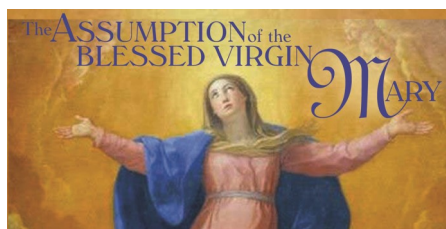
Here in God's family all find their home.
