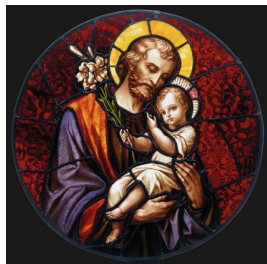

15th of March: Feast of St. Clement Hofbauer, Redemptorist:
born in Tasswitz (Czech Republic) in 1751 he died in Vienna in 1820. He
came to Italy in 1784 where he joined the Redemptorist Congregation and
was ordained a priest in 1785. He then founded the first
Redemptorist Community north of the Alps in Warsaw
where he worked for over twenty years before moving
to Vienna in 1808. He was renowned for his zeal and
courageous initiatives in both these cities at a time
when the political powers were making life very
difficult for the Catholic Church.



19th of March, Feast of St. Joseph,
frequently described as a just man, this means he
was a person who was completely open to what
God wanted. He became holy by being totally
obedient to God's will in marrying Mary, in
caring for Mary and Jesus, in guiding them to
Egypt, in returning to Nazareth. All who frequent
St. Joseph's Church can be justly
proud of this patron saint.
