Pope Francis published an exhortation last week called *The Joy of Love: On Love in the Family*. This is his reflection resulting from the Synod which was held last year about the mission of the family. In a comment about this exhortation Archbishop Eamon Martin said “the document has a warm, distinctive and familiar style that speaks to the reality of ordinary life. It is very much in tune with the concrete realities of everyday life as lived by married couples and families. The document reflects the vision of Pope Francis in that we cannot resort to doctrine without considering the complexities of married life.....As a Church we are used to inviting people to come to us, but from today Pope Francis urges us to reach out and offer support, at a local level, for those preparing for marriage and for those on the journey of married life.”
