

Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> of May, feast of the apostles Philip and James: St. Philip was born in Bethsaida. Initially he was a disciple of John the Baptist and then became a follower of Jesus. St. James ruled the Church in Jerusalem where he converted many to the faith. He also wrote an epistle which includes the verse 'What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but do not have works. '(James 2,14).

Thursday, 5th of May, feast of Blessed Edmund Rice: the founder of the Irish Christian Brothers opened his first school Mount Sion in Waterford in the early 1800s. Later the Congregation spread throughout Ireland and also to many countries overseas. Coláiste Rís in Dundalk is a reminder of the work of education initiated by Edmund Rice 200 years ago.
