Laudato Si, the encyclical of Pope Francis about the environment (caring for our common home) was published a year ago this week. It still challenges us to be more committed to caring for our environment. Pope Francis states - *'at all levels a change of mindset is needed. It is the same mindset that is needed to tackle both climate change and world poverty'* (Laudato Si, p. 175).

All powerful God, you are present in the whole universe and in the smallest of your creatures. You embrace with your tenderness all that exists. Pour out upon us the power of your love, that we may protect life and beauty. Fill us with peace, that we may live as brothers and sisters, harming no one. (Laudato Si, p. 246)

O God of the poor, help us to rescue the abandoned and forgotten of this earth, so precious in your eyes. Bring healing to our lives, that we may protect the world and not prey on it, that we may sow beauty, not pollution and destruction. (Laudato Si, p. 246).

13th of June, Feast of St. Anthony of Padua: he was born in Portugal in 1195. He joined the Augustinian order but later changed to become a Franciscan. He was renowned for his preaching, particularly in France and Italy. He died in Padua in 1231. *'A person who is filled with the Holy Spirit speaks several languages. These several languages are the various ways of witnessing to Christ, such as humility, poverty, obedience and patience, with which we speak when we practice them towards our neighbor. Language comes alive when it speaks by deeds'* (from a sermon of St. Anthony).

Father's Day (19th of June): the African Catholic Community in Dundalk will have Mass at 2pm in St. Nicholas Church followed by a reception in St. Nicholas Hall.
