A gathering in reflection, solidarity and prayer for the victims, survivors and families of the Orlando massacre. Monday, June 20th at 8.15pm, Redemptorist Church, Dundalk

Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> of June, is the memorial of The Irish Martyrs. Seventeen Irish people, men and women, cleric and lay were put to death for the Catholic faith between 1579 and 1654 and were beatified in 1992 by Pope John Paul II. Amongst these were Dermot Hurley – Archbishop of Cashel, John Kearney (a Franciscan), William Tirry (an Augustinian), Francis Taylor (mayor of Dublin), Matthew Lambert (a baker from Wexford) and Margaret Birmingham (Dublin).

Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> of June, is the feast of The Nativity of St. John the Baptist. John used the expression - 'He must increase, I must decrease' in a reference to Jesus and that was a summary of his life's mission. He helped prepare the way and placed the focus on Jesus, who was sent by the Father to proclaim the Good News of salvation.
