St. Kilian's feast day is on the 8th of July. He was born in Mullagh, Co. Cavan in 640 and with eleven companions went in 686 to an area in Germany which is part of Bavaria. He was put to death in 689 together with his companions Colmán and Totnan. There is widespread devotion to him in Wurzburg and in the surrounding area. In Mullagh there is the St. Kilian heritage centre organized by the local community and supported by the diocese of Wurzburg.
