**The Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne is celebrated on the 26<sup>th</sup> of July.** We have very little solid information about the parents of Mary of Nazareth but can reasonably presume that they were prayerful persons. This date is in many countries 'grandparents' day and so it is an opportunity to acknowledge the very important role of grandparents who generously give of their time to help care for their grandchildren.

**The Feast of Saint James the Apostle is celebrated on the 25<sup>th</sup> of July.** He and his brother John, sons of Zebedee, were apostles. James is venerated especially in Santiago de Compostella (Spain) where there is a church dedicated in his honour. This has become better known in recent times by those who have participated in the pilgrimage *El Camino*.
