

The feast of St. Pius X is celebrated on the 21st of August. He was born in 1835 and was Pope from 1903 to 1914. He is remembered by many as the Pope who encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion. He also encouraged Italian Catholics to become more politically involved. One of his first papal acts was to end the supposed rights of governments to interfere by veto in papal elections. In 1905 when France renounced its agreement with the Holy See and threatened confiscation of church property if governmental control of church affairs were not granted, he courageously rejected the demand. He was canonized in 1954.
