14th of November, feast of St. Laurence O'Toole (1123-1180): He was a monk in Glendalough and later its abbot. He became archbishop of Dublin in 1162. He was deeply concerned with reform in the church and freeing it from secular control. The Norman invasion in 1169 changed the course of Irish history and he became involved in brokering peace between the Normans and the citizens of Dublin. In his mission he never lost sight of the need to minister to the poor and the needy.

Pope Francis in his exhortation about Family life says: *Jesus began his public ministry with the miracle at the wedding feast of Cana. (Jn 2,1-11). He shared in everyday moments of friendship with the family of Lazarus and his sisters (Lk 10.38) and with the family of Peter (Mt 8.14). He sympathized with grieving parents and restored their children to life (Mk 5.41; Lk 7.14-15). In this way he demonstrated the true meaning of mercy, which entails the restoration of the covenant. This is clear from his conversations with the Samaritan woman (John 4. 1-30) and with the woman found in adultery (John 8.1-11), where the consciousness of sin is awakened by an encounter with His gratuitous love.
