Mass on Easter Sunday will be at the usual Sunday times –

# Confession times in St. Joseph's during Holy Week will be as follows:

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday : 10.00am to 11.00am and 7.00pm to 7.20pm

Thursday, from 10.00am to 7.00pm Friday, from 10.00am to 2.30pm and from 4.30pm to 7.00pm. Saturday, from 10.00am to 7.00pm. Palm Sunday: As Holy Week begins we bring together the coming of Christ in triumph into Jerusalem and the proclamation of his Passion. Jesus is the firm ground of our hope that good will triumph over evil, that life will triumph over death.

Holy Thursday: The gospel reading describes an extraordinary gesture of service that Jesus does for his disciples by washing their feet. This was normally done by servants. In this way Jesus shows that he sees himself as a servant of others.

Participation in the Eucharist commissions us to be servants of one another.

Good Friday: The liturgy has four main parts – i) the readings from Isaiah, from the letter to the Hebrews and John's account of the Passion and Death of Jesus; ii) the intercessions, which we refer to more commonly as the Prayers of the Faithful; iii) the solemn veneration of the Cross and iv) the communion service.

Easter Vigil: This night of the Passover when Christ passed from death to life is the most important moment in the entire Christian year. We keep vigil knowing that the Lord will rise triumphant from the dead.
