The Feast of St. Mark Evangelist is on the 25th of April. He was not one of the twelve apostles but became a co-worker with Peter, Paul and Barnabas. His gospel is the shortest and was the first one to be written, probably between the years 60 and 70 – about thirty years after the death of Jesus. His gospel was a very important source for Matthew and Luke.

The Feast of St. Catherine of Siena is on the 29th of April. She lived in the 14th century and worked hard for the unity of the Church at a time of great division. In 1970 she was declared a doctor of the church and in 2000 was named as a patron of Europe.
