**St. Joseph the Worker** is commemorated on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May. This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XII in 1955. Work is central to our lives and this is an opportunity to appreciate the work of so many people whose efforts make life better for us all. It is important also to pray for those whose work is not appreciated or who do not have work.

**Blessed Edmund Rice** is commemorated on the 5<sup>th</sup> of May. He was born in Callan, Co. Kilkenny in 1762 and died in Waterford in 1844. He founded the Congregation of the Irish Christian Brothers in 1802 in Waterford. His zealous initiative provided educational opportunity for generations of young people throughout the country, who otherwise would not have had such an opportunity. Edmund Rice was also the founder of the Presentation Brothers. He was beatified in 1996.
