Saints of the Week: Tuesday: Blessed Gaspar Stangassinger \* C.Ss.R. (1871-1899). He was born in Germany and entered the Redemptorist novitiate in 1892 and was ordained to the \* 🖟 priesthood in 1895. He worked in the minor seminary until his 🧩 \* death in 1899. He was noted for his very intense prayer life. His \* beatification took place in 1988.

Wednesday: St. Vincent de Paul (1581-1660). He was the founder \*\* \* of the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) which was \* committed to bringing the good news to the poor in remote rural \* areas. His life's work inspired Blessed Frederic Ozanam many \* years later to found the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Lord, help 🧩 me to make time today to serve you in those who are most in 🥋 \* need of encouragement and assistance. (St. Vincent de Paul).

\* Friday: SS. Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels. Each of \* these archangels performs a different task – Michael protects (for \* example, he the people of Israel as related in Chapter 12 of the \* Apocalypse); Gabriel announces (for example, to Mary of \*\* 🖟 Nazareth that she was to be the mother of Jesus as related in 🧩 \* Luke's Gospel) and Raphael guides (for example, Tobiah in the \* 🔆 book of Tobit).

Saturday: St. Jerome was born in the 4th century. He acquired a \* great love of the bible and wrote many commentaries which \* helped people to deepen their understanding of the Word of God.
