# Saints of the Week

**o6 November, Feast of All the Saints of Ireland**: this is an opportunity to express gratitude for all those who in past generations have given witness to the gospel in this country, who have lived their Christian lives as best they could. Sometimes that happened under very difficult circumstances. The feast also encourages this generation to help one another to grow in faith and to be compassionate with those who have difficulties in regard to faith.

07 November - Redemptorist Martyrs of Cuenca, **Spain:** their martyrdom happened in the context of the Spanish civil war (1930s), where religious persecution was prevalent. Their names were Joseph Xavier (shot), Ciriaco Olarte (beaten to death), Victor Calvo (brutally murdered), Julian Pozo (shot), Michael Goni (shot) and Peter Romero (died in prison). They were beatified in 2013.

God our Father, through baptism and religious profession, you led Blessed Joseph Xavier and his companions to the saving mustery of your Son, and enabled them to bear witness to Plentiful Redemption by their fidelity even in the face of martyrdom. Grant us, we pray, through their intercession, strength in faith and generosity in love.
