Eighth Station: Jesus Speaks to the Women: Some women were crying for him. He told them not to shed tears for him but to shed tears for themselves. They had not accepted him as the Messiah. They did not understand but I did and as he walked on I followed silently.

Ninth Station: Jesus falls the Third Time: This fall of Jesus was agony to me as he was almost at the top of the hill of crucifixion. The soldiers screamed at him and I imagined what they would do next. I knew this had to be and so I climbed the hill silently behind him.
