Holy Week: The community celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth. It is a time for prayer and reflection about our faith.

Palm Sunday: The triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem is in stark contrast to the Passion and Death which await him.

Holy Thursday: The Eucharist is a unique gift given to us by God. When we break bread and share the cup we proclaim the death of the Lord. On this day we commit ourselves to a life of service to the community.

Good Friday: The community recalls the passion and death of Jesus. The afternoon ceremony has three main parts – Readings of the Word, Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion.

Holy Saturday: The only Eucharist celebrated on this day is the Easter Vigil at 9.00pm when the community celebrates with great joy the Resurrection of the

Pope Francis in his exhortation about Marriage and the Family says: We cannot forget that the larger family includes fathers-in-law, mothers-in-law and all the relatives of the couples. One particularly delicate aspect of love is learning not to view these relatives as somehow competitors, threats or intruders. Marriage demands respect for their traditions, caring for them and cherishing them while maintaining the legitimate privacy and independence of the couple. (paragraph 198).
