01 November – the Feast of All Saints: The Second Vatican Council (1962–1965) reminded us that we are all called to holiness. In other words, we are all called to grow in faith, to live out our baptism as well as we possibly can, to become the people that God wants us to be. Down through history the processes of beatification and canonization have recognized the efforts and example of many people to do precisely that. We are familiar with the feast days of saints – for example – Mary of Nazareth, St. Francis, St. Joseph, St. Patrick, St. Brigid, St. Therese of Lisieux and many others. Today the Church recalls all those people who may not have their own designated feast day but who lived their baptismal calling in a serious and committed way and who certainly led lives of holiness. Each of us can identify such people – perhaps a parent or grandparent or other relative, a neighbour or a teacher, a person dedicated to charitable practices or a friend always ready to help those in need. Today we celebrate our gratitude to God for all these people. And let us allow ourselves to be inspired by them as we continue our journey in search of greater holiness in our own lives.
