02 November: Commemoration of All Souls: It is a long standing tradition in the Church to pray for our deceased brothers and sisters. We do so because in life they were near and dear to us. We pray because we believe that God’s love is eternal and that he welcomes people to the heavenly home. At some point during the year practically all communities have a Cemetery Sunday, a day to visit and pray at the graveside of those who have passed on. It is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead.

03 November, Feast of St Martin de Porres (1579-1639): Born in Peru of mixed race—his mother was from Panama and his father from Spain—Martin was reared in poverty in the city of Lima. He was accepted by the Dominicans to be a helper in their community. Such was his commitment to prayer and work he was invited to make his full religious profession and this he did. He was known for his dedication to the poor and the sick, regardless of their colour, race or status in society.

06 November—the Feast of All the Saints of Ireland: This is an opportunity for us to celebrate and express our gratitude for all the generations who through their commitment and witness handed on the faith in this country. We are mindful not only of those who are publicly acknowledged by the Church to be saints but also of those whose Christian lives were an inspiration to others even though their names may not be widely known. This feast is also an opportunity for our generation to renew our own commitment to the living of our faith and through our witness help younger generations to accept the gift of faith which God offers.
