

The people that walked in darkness has seen a great light'. (Isaiah 9,1)

And this is the name they give him: Wonder Counsellor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9,6)

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the messenger who announces peace, who brings good news Who announces salvation, who says to Zion, 'Your God reigns.' (Isaiah 52,7)

While they were there the time came for her to have her child and she gave birth to a son, her first born. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger because there was no room for them at the inn'. (Luke 2, 6-7)

And suddenly with the angel was a great throng of the heavenly host, praising God and singing: Glory to God in the highest heaven and peace to men who enjoy his favour'. (Luke 2,14)
