Keeping St Joseph's Safe

Given the recent rise in Covid 19 cases in the community, this may be a good time to remind ourselves of safety measures. It is important that we comply with social distancing and hygiene etiquette and use facemasks when in the body of the church. Please follow the guidance of stewards especially when moving around the church. Our church has been approved to be divided into 2 sections, each accommodating 50, in addition to St Gerard's Hall. Although this provides ample capacity for numbers attending, it requires your cooperation. Please note the following:

1. Please adhere to the directions of the stewards at all times, especially with respect to the one way system.
2. Approach for communion in a single file up the centre aisle and maintain adequate distance and return via the side aisles.
3. If you are unable to walk the distance to the front, please remain in your seats and a Eucharistic Minister will come to you.
4. Please step out of your seat to allow others in rather than having people cross in front of you.
5. If our stewards deem that the church has reached capacity, you will be directed to St Gerard's hall. Please do not insist on standing at the back.

I wish to assure you our parishioners and those who worship here in St. Joseph's that every effort has been made to make our Church a safe and spiritual experience.
