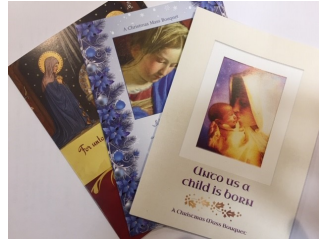

A special “Week of Witness” will be celebrated in the Archdiocese of Armagh commemorating those who have given great witness to their faith in the past and those who continue to give witness today and all who will continue to give great witness in the future. The week will be launched on **24th November** at the 10.30am Mass in St Patrick’s Cathedral, Armagh.
