Second Sunday of Easter 28th April 2019

The 2nd Sunday of Easter is designated Divine Mercy Sunday.

Monday, 29th of April, is the feast of St. Catherine of Siena, Patron of Europe. She lived in the 14th century and helped bring peace to her city, to Italy and to Europe.

Wednesday, 1st of May, is the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. Joseph was a carpenter by trade and to-day's feast reminds us that manual labour dignifies the person who does it.

Friday, 3rd of May, is the feast of Saints Philip and James, Apostles. Philip was a disciple of John the Baptist and became a follower of Jesus. James ruled the church in Jerusalem and was martyred in the year 62.
