The **2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter** is designated Divine Mercy Sunday.

**Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> of April**, is the feast of St. Catherine of Siena, Patron of Europe. She lived in the 14<sup>th</sup> century and helped bring peace to her city, to Italy and to Europe.

**Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> of May**, is the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. Joseph was a carpenter by trade and to-day's feast reminds us that manual labour dignifies the person who does it.

**Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> of May**, is the feast of Saints Philip and James, Apostles. Philip was a disciple of John the Baptist and became a follower of Jesus. James ruled the church in Jerusalem and was martyred in the year 62.

**An Open Day at St. Joseph's will be held on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May from 3.00pm to 6.00pm.** This will be an opportunity to meet representatives of the various ministries in St. Joseph's.
