◆ **Communion**

An update on the communion process at St Joseph's.

On Sundays and other larger gatherings, special attention must be paid to safety during communion. The following system is now in place:

- Communion will be distributed in sections.
- Please wait until the Eucharistic Ministers are in their designated stations.
- You are invited to come forward row by row beginning at the back rows of each section.
- Please approach the Eucharistic minister in single file on the RHS of the aisle and return on the LHS
- Please do not approach the Eucharist Minister from behind.
- If you cannot come forward for Holy Communion, please indicate to a Eucharistic Minister and they will come to you at the end.
- Gluten free Host is available at St. Gerard's Shrine.
- We thank you for your continued co-operation in keeping St Joseph's a safe place of worship, the stewards will **no** longer guide you during the communion process and we invited you to wait for your rows turn to approach the minister and to take your time during this process.
