Pope Francis, in his letter *The Joy of the Gospel*, wrote: *The word of God constantly shows us how God challenges those who believe in him 'to go forth'. Abraham received the call to set out for a new land. Moses heard God's call and led the people towards the promised land. To Jeremiah, God says – 'To all whom I send you, you shall go. In our day, Jesus' command to go and make disciples' is a reminder that all of us are called to take part in this new missionary 'going forth'. Each Christian and every community must discern the path that the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey his call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the 'peripheries' in need of the light of the Gospel.*

Fr. Clement MacMánuis C.Ss.R. R.I.P. You have probably already heard of the death of Fr. Clement last week-end in Belfast. He was born and reared in Alphonsus Villas and, at a young age, he became an altar server in St. Joseph's and came to know many Redemptorists. He became one himself in 1963 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1969. Much of his priestly ministry was dedicated to parish missions, but he also worked in youth ministry as well as in parish ministry in Gaeltacht areas.
