# Sunday 24th March 2024. Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion.

**Pope Francis**, in his letter Laudate Deum, writes – The Bible tells us –'God saw everything that he had made, it was very good. His is the earth with all that is in it.' For this reason, he tells us that, 'the land shall not be sold in perpetuity, for the land is mine; with me you are but aliens and tenants'. Hence, 'responsibility for God's earth means that human beings, endowed with intelligence, must respect the laws of nature and the delicate equilibria existing between the creatures of this world'.
