Redemptorist Reference 1: The feast of St. Alphonsus, founder of the Congregation, is celebrated on the 1st of August. St. Alphonsus was born in 1696 in Naples. He trained as a lawyer but became disillusioned with the workings of the judicial system. He then prepared for the priesthood and was ordained in 1726. He became aware of spiritually and pastorally abandoned people in the area near Amalfi and this motivated him to found a congregation that would dedicate its missionary efforts to the most abandoned. Thus, the Redemptorist Congregation was founded on the 9th of November 1732. There are approximately 5000 Redemptorists across the world at this time.

Redemptorist Reference 2: The Redemptorist Congregation is organized on the basis of provinces across the world. Greater contact and cooperation are being encouraged between provinces in the same region. In practice this means that the federation of North-West Europe is being formed by the provinces of Dublin, London, Vienna-Munich and St. Clement (Northern Germany, Netherlands and Switzerland). The federation will be officially inaugurated on the 1st of August in a ceremony in Limerick.

Redemptorist Reference 3: The Redemptorist Youth Congresses begins in Limerick on the 30th of July and continues until the 3rd of August. Please pray for its success: God of love, master bridge builder, bless us as we gather at this Redemptorist Youth Congress. At the Crib, we witness Your loving vulnerability, help us build bridges to those on the margins. Called to Your manger, send us to the forgotten. At the Cross, Your outstretched arms bridge heaven and earth, make us instruments of reconciliation and healing. Called to Your sacrifice, send us to heal what's broken. With Mary, whose heart burned with Divine Love, teach us to build bridges of justice and inclusion. Called by her "yes," send us to uplift the lowly. In the Eucharist, You unite us as one body. Transform us into bridges of communion. Called to Your table, send us to share Your love. God of Love, make us bridges of hope, called and sent in the name of Jesus our Redeemer. Amen.
