Mission Sunday: In 1926 Pope Pius XI designated the second last Sunday of October to be Mission Sunday. It is a reminder that the church exists for mission, that is, to proclaim the Word of God in word and deed. While the collection at this week-end's Masses will be forwarded to support missionary efforts in poorer countries overseas, we are reminded that it is both possible and necessary for all of us to be missionary. Our attitudes and our deeds are a measure of that missionary commitment.
