Pope Leo, in his letter *Dilexi Te* (I have loved you) writes: Love for the Lord is one with love for the poor. The same Jesus who tells us, 'The poor you will always have with you' (Mt 26.11), also promises the disciples: 'I am with you always' (Mt. 28.20). We likewise think of his saying 'Just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me.' (Mt 25.10). Contact with those who are lowly and powerless is a fundamental way of encountering the Lord of history. In the poor, he continues to speak to us. (paragraph 5). This Sunday is the World Day of the Poor.

The feast of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated on the 21st of November (Friday).
