**Second Sunday of Lent.**

**Pope Leo** in his letter *Dilexi Te* writes: *Despite their poverty, the early Christians were clearly aware of the necessity to care for those who were most in need. Already at the dawn of Christianity, the apostles chose seven men from the community and instituted them for the service of the poorest. (Acts 6,1-5). Stephen, who was to become the first martyr, was one of this group of seven, known as deacons. (par. 37)*
