The Triduum in honour of the 300th Anniversary of the birth of St. Gerard Majella will take place on the 13th, 14th and 15th of April. We will have three sessions each day: at 9.30am, at 1.10pm and at 7.30pm.

Day 1, 13th of April: Fr. Brendan O Rourke will speak about St. Gerard and Trust in God.

Day 2, 14th of April: Fr. Ryan Holovlasky will speak about St. Gerard and Brotherhood.

Day 3, 15th of April, Colum Óg Marks will speak about St. Gerard, an Inspiration for Young People.

The Holy Week and Easter Ceremonies are very special moments in the life of a Christian community, and this year was no different in St. Joseph's. A word of thanks is due to all who participated, to those who prepared the church for each of the ceremonies and to those who undertook the many liturgical roles. May the Spirit of the Risen Lord continue to guide our steps.

Redemptorist Reference: on the 13th of April 1950 the Redemptorist houses in what was then Czechoslovakia were suppressed. The younger Redemptorists were conscripted into the army and others were condemned to life imprisonment.

Pope Leo, in his letter *Dilexi Te* writes: *The Church's tradition of working for and with migrants continues. Pope Francis summed up our responsibility in four verbs: welcome, protect, promote and integrate. These words describe the mission of the church in relation to all those who live in precarious circumstances. Migrants and refugees are not a problem to be solved, but are brothers and sisters to be welcomed, respected and loved.*

Collection and Envelopes: last week's collection was €5,740.63. The contribution from the Parish Envelopes was €1,814.60. The collection on Holy Thursday for the support of the poor was €1,100.94 - this has been donated to the Simon Community. The collection on Good Friday for the support of the Holy Places in the Holy Land was €1,816.93. This has been forwarded to the archdiocese who will send it to the Holy Land. We are grateful as always for your generosity.
