Easter Sunday: The Easter celebrations are the high point of our liturgical year. Life has conquered death. Christ our hope is risen. We live in a world that is in dire need of hope, as we are reminded of on a daily basis in our news bulletins. We need to know that somebody cares for us. We are reassured that there is a way of being human other than war and destruction and enmity. The God of love and compassion who raised Jesus from the dead does care for us and so we can have hope in our hearts. We are called to be witnesses of the Risen Lord in our day to day lives, by showing that we believe in goodness, in justice and in truth, by sharing the good news of God's Kingdom with one another.

The Triduum in honour of the 300th Anniversary of the birth of St. Gerard Majella will take place on the 13th, 14th and 15th of April.

We will have three sessions each day: at 9.30am, at 1.10pm and at 7.30pm.

Day 1, 13th of April: Fr. Brendan O Rourke will speak about St. Gerard and Trust in God.

Day 2, 14th of April: Fr. Ryan Holovlasky will speak about St. Gerard and Brotherhood.

Day 3, 15th of April, Colum Óg Marks will speak about St. Gerard, an Inspiration for Young People.

All are welcome to the triduum. Please inform your neighbours and friends about it.
